

## **Daffodils that do well in our area**

– according to Loyce McKenzie, Spring 2011

### **Division 1**

Trumpet 1 flower per stem, long cup/corona

- Bravoure

### **Division 2**

Large Cup 1 flower per stem, shorter cup, corona

- Accent
- Ceylon
- Chromacolor
- Fragrant Rose
- Monal
- Saint Keverne

### **Division 5**

Tirandrus usually 2 or more pendent flowers to a stem, often with fruity fragrance

- Ice Wings

### **Division 6**

Cyclamineus 1 flower to a stem, flower at acute angle to the stem, with a short neck.

- Beryl
- Rapture

### **Division 7**

Jonquilla 1 to 5 flowers per stem, usually fragrant

- Golden Echo
- Hillstar
- Intrigue
- Stratosphere
- Sweetness (Heirloom 1939)
- Division 8 – Tazetta – 3 to 20 flowers per stem, leaves broad, fragrant
- Falconet
- Division 11A – Collar Daffodils
- Tripartite
- Miniatures – flowers about 1” in diameter and about 6” tall
- Fernandesii
- Hawera
- Jonquilla var. henriquesii
- Kokopelli
- Pacific Coast
- Spoirot
